✿ Developer **David Kramer** has been working on Roosevelt Island since 1996, and he still can't understand why every New Yorker hasn't visited the island where apartments cost 30 to 40 percent less than in Manhattan.

Partnering with **Related Companies**, Kramer's **Hudson Companies Inc.** has built six luxury rental and condominium buildings (below) on the island and recently completed a seven-store retail compound that includes everything a New York neighborhood could need—a sushi restaurant, bar and grill, drugstore, **Starbucks**, beauty salon, dry cleaning and pizzeria.

Now his task is to get people there. Working with Related, Kramer created Roosevelt Live as a summer music, arts and entertainment festival.

"Most developers focus on marketing the building," says Kramer. "We wanted to go beyond that and spice up the summer with events that show off this island."

This weekend, the **Albert Ayler Festival** celebrates the life of the deceased jazz great with a series of performances tomorrow from 2 to 10 p.m. On July 18 at 3 p.m., Mardi Gras meets Carnival when New Orleans musicians and Brazilian beat players share the bill.
